



We are a small **charity based in Brighton** supporting refugees, asylum seekers and vulnerable migrants, including those with no recourse to public funds.

At this time of national crisis, our services are needed more than ever. Demand on our **independent food bank** has increased dramatically, and people increasingly need reliable, clear **advice** about their rights and entitlements in a fast-changing policy landscape.

We are very low on food stocks and donations, which means we are struggling to provide clients with basic goods. We also need funding so we can increase the number of people we can help and ensure we keep our volunteers and staff safe. Our aim is to support over **150 clients and family members** with food each week, but to do this we will need £1,500 every month.
